- Shoe cushions/insoles (for uncomfortable shoes)
- White chalk (mask stains on your dress)

- Nail polish in the color of your manicure
- Clear nail polish
- Tampons & pads
- Headache medicine
- Tissues*
- Visine
- Band-Aids
- Lotion

Sustenance

- Water
- Energy bars & mess-free/grease-free snacks
- Straws
- Cell Phone Charger

Hair & Makeup

- Bobby pins for both blondes and brunettes*
- Hair spray
- Compact mirror*
- Lipstick*
- Nail file
- Tweezers
- Blotting papers
- Cotton swabs

Décor

- Tape
- Scissors
- Sharpie pen
- Elegant pens (if guest book pens are lost)
- Long handled candle-lighter for votives
- Extra floral pins (very long pins for pinning boutonnieres)
